Summary of the Law

Epiclesis

Anamnesis

Presider: Before He was given up to death, a death He freely accepted, He took bread and gave You thanks. He broke the bread, gave it to His disciples, and said,

“Take, eat: this is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”

Presider: When supper was ended, He took the cup. Again He gave You thanks and praise, gave the cup to his disciples, and said:

“Drink this, all of you. This is My Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this for the remembrance of Me.”

Breaking of the Bread

Christ our Passover (*Pascha Nostrum*)

Presider: Hallelujah! Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us!

*People: Therefore, let us keep the feast.
Hallelujah!*

Invitation to Communion

Presider: Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him Who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the Supper of the Lamb.

People: *Lord, I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof, but say only the word and my soul shall be healed.*

Presider: The gifts of God for the people of God:
Take them in remembrance that Jesus died for you, and feed on Him in your hearts with thanksgiving.

Prayer for Receiving Spiritual Communion

All: *My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.*

Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You are already there, and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.
