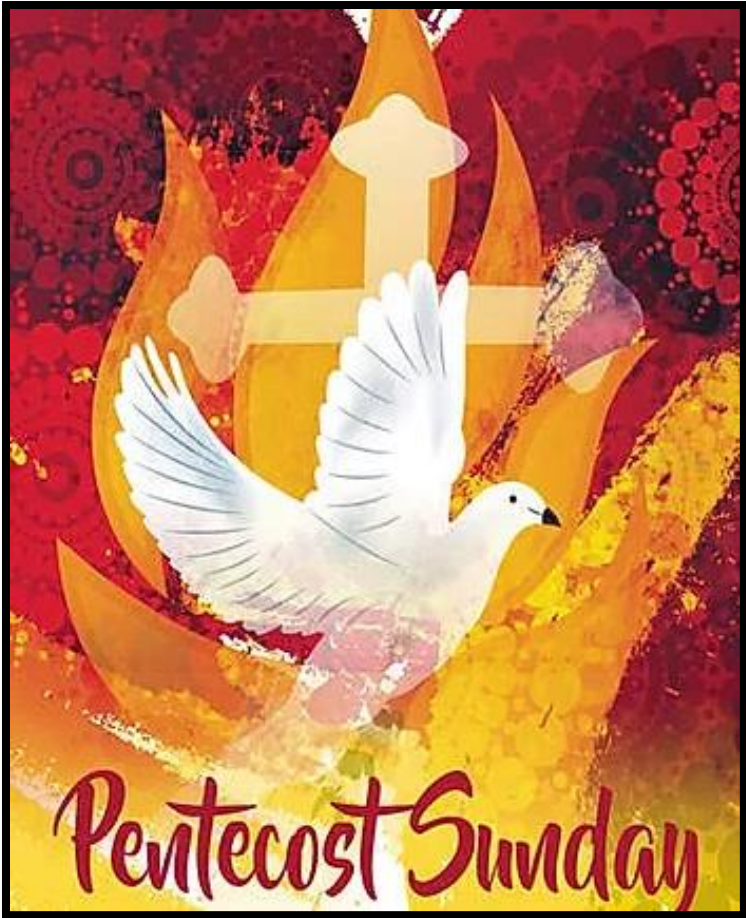

Penitential Rite

Summary of the Law

Deacon: Jesus said, “The first Commandment is this:
Hear, O Israel: the Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord Your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.

The second is this: Love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these.

Deacon: Dearly beloved, let us come into the presence of the Almighty God, praying together as we kneel:

All: Amen.

Homily

Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of Heaven and earth, and of all things: visible and invisible. Preparation of the Gifts

Presider: Blessed are You Lord, God of all creation. For through Your goodness we have received the bread we offer You: fruit of the earth and work of human hands, it will become the Body of Christ.

People: Blessed be God forever.

Presider: By the mystery of this water and wine may we come to share in the divinity of Christ, who humbled Himself to share in our humanity.

Presider: Blessed are You Lord, God of all creation, for through Your goodness we have received the wine we offer You, fruit of the vine and work of human hands; it will become the Blood of Christ.

People: Blessed be God forever.

Presider: Blessed are You Lord, God of all creation, for through Your goodness we bring these tithes and offerings before You. They will be used in Your church for the work You have set before us and the furthering of Your kingdom.

Presider: Wash me, O Lord, from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.

Exhortation To Pray (*Orate fratres*)

Presider: Pray, brothers and sisters, that our sacrifice may be acceptable to God, the Almighty Father.

Great Thanksgiving

Presider: The Lord be with you.

People: And with your spirit.

People: It is right to give Him thanks and praise.

Presider: Father, all powerful and everliving God, we do well always and everywhere to give You thanks. Today You sent the Holy Spirit on those marked out to be Your children by sharing the life of Your Son, and so You brought the paschal mystery to completion.

Today we celebrate the great beginning of Your church when the Holy Spirit made known to all peoples the one true God, and created from the many languages of man one voice to profess one faith. Today You poured out the gifts of tongues and prophecy, and filled Your church with the blessings of the Spirit that we might continue to preach, teach, heal, cast out demons, and proclaim the good news of Your Kingdom.

Therefore we praise You, joining our voices with angels, archangels, patriarchs, prophets, apostles, martyrs and the whole company of heaven in their unending hymn of praise:

Eucharistic Prayer VIII CEC

Presider: We give You praise, Father most holy, for You are great and You have fashioned all Your works in wisdom and in love. You formed man in Your own image and entrusted the whole world to his care, so that in serving You alone, the Creator, He might have dominion over all creatures.

And when through disobedience he had lost Your fellowship, You did not abandon him to the domain of death. For You came in mercy to the aid of all, so that those who seek might find You. Time and again You offered covenant with man, and through the prophets taught him to look forward to salvation.

And You so loved the world, Father most holy, that in the fullness of time You sent Your only begotten Son to be our Savior. Made incarnate by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary, He shared our human nature in all things but sin. To the poor He proclaimed the good news of salvation, to prisoners, freedom, and to the sorrowful of heart, joy. To accomplish Your plan, He gave himself up to death, and rising from the dead, He destroyed death and restored life.

Presider: And that we might live no longer for ourselves, but for Him who died and rose again for us, You sent the Holy Spirit, Father, as the first fruits for those who believe, so that, bringing to perfection His work in the world, He might sanctify creation to the full.

Invocation of the Holy Spirit

Presider: Therefore, O Lord, we pray: may this same Holy Spirit graciously sanctify these ✠ offerings, that they may become the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, for the celebration of this great mystery, which He himself left us as an eternal covenant.

Words of Institution

Presider: For when the hour had come for Him to be glorified by You, Father most holy, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end. And while they were at supper He took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to His disciples, saying:

**“Take, eat: This is My Body,
which is given for you. Do this for the
remembrance of Me.”**

Presider: In a similar way, taking the cup filled with the fruit of the vine, He gave thanks and gave the cup to His disciples, saying:

**“Drink this, all of you: This is My Blood
of the New Covenant, which is shed for
you and for many for the forgiveness of
sins. Whenever you drink it, do this for
the remembrance of Me.”**

Mystery of Faith

Presider: Let us proclaim the mystery of faith:

*All: Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will
come again.*

Prayer for the Church

Presider: Therefore, O Lord, as we now celebrate the memorial of our redemption, we remember Christ’s death and His descent to the realm of the dead. We proclaim His resurrection and His ascension to Your right hand, and, as we

await His coming in glory, we offer You His Body and Blood.

Look, O Lord, upon the sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving which You Yourself have provided for Your church, and grant in Your loving kindness to all who partake of this one bread and one cup that, gathered into one body by the Holy Spirit, they may truly become a living sacrifice in Christ to the praise of Your glory.

Presider: Therefore, Lord, remember now your servant Craig, our Patriarch, Ricardo, our Primate, Ariel, our Bishop, and the whole order of Bishops. Remember all the clergy, especially those who take part in the offering, as well as your people gathered here before you, seeking you with sincere hearts.

Presider: To all of us, Your children, grant, O merciful Father, that we may enter into a heavenly inheritance with the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, and with Your apostles and saints in Your kingdom. There, with the whole of creation freed from the corruption of sin and death, may we glorify You through Christ our Lord, through whom You bestow on the world all that is good.
