## Penitential Rite

### Summary of the Law

Deacon: Jesus said, “The first Commandment is this: Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord Your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.

The second is this: Love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these.

Presider: When supper was ended, He took the cup. Again He gave You thanks and praise, gave the cup to his disciples, and said:

**“Drink this, all of you. This is My Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this for the remembrance of Me.”**

### Mysterium Fidei

Presider: Let us proclaim the mystery of faith.

*All: Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again!*

Presider: In memory of His death and resurrection, we offer You, Father, this life-giving bread, this saving cup. We thank You for counting us worthy to stand in Your presence and serve You. Humbly we pray that, partaking of the Body and Blood of Christ, we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit.

Presider: Lord, remember Your church throughout the world; make us grow in love, together with our Patriarch Craig, our Primate Ricardo, our Bishop Ariel, and all the clergy.

## Invitation to Communion

**Presider:** Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him Who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the Supper of the Lamb.

**People:** *Lord, I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof, but say only the word and my soul shall be healed.*

**Presider:** The gifts of God for the people of God:  
Take them in remembrance that Jesus died for you, and feed on Him in your hearts with thanksgiving.

## Prayer for Receiving Spiritual Communion

**All:** *My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.*

*Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You are already there, and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.*
